

Vaccinations for Goats:

- Pregnant Doe – Last month of pregnancy with Clostridium C & D plus Tetanus (Covexin 8). Booster Annually
- Kids – At 1-2 months of age if from vaccinated doe, then a booster at 3 weeks and then a second booster at 3-4 weeks later (Covexin 8).
- Kids from non-immunized Doe – Vaccinate at 1-3 weeks of age followed by 2 booster doses at 3-4 week intervals.
- Bucks – Vaccinate at same time as Does (Covexin 8).
- Yearlings – Vaccinate one year after first vaccines given (Covexin 8).

Vaccinations for Sheep:

- Pregnant Ewes – 2-6 weeks before lambing vaccinate for Clostridium C & D (Covexin 8).
- Lambs – 10 -12 weeks of age vaccinate for Clostridium (Covexin 8) then booster 6 weeks later. Follow this with annual vaccination.
- Lambs to non-immunized Ewes – vaccinate for Clostridium (Covexin 8) at 1-3 weeks followed by two more boosters at 3-4 week intervals.
